Model 700 Added Calibers 300 Win.Mag. and 6MM Rem.

1964

Model 1100 16 and 20 Gauges - Autoloading Shotgun  
Replacing same gauges in Sportsman-58

Model 600 Carbine - Bolt Action Center Fire Rifle  
Calibers 222 Rem., 6MM Rem., 308 Win. and 35 Rem.

Model 760 Center Fire Pump Rifle  
Added Caliber 223 Rem.

1965

Model 600 Added a Magnum version in Caliber 350 Rem.Mag.  
with special laminated stock.

Model 700 Added Caliber 22/250.

Model 1100 Added a Deer Gun grade for this autoloading shotgun  
with special barrel and sights - 12 Gauge.

1966

Model 600 Carbine - Added 6.5MM Caliber

Models 742 & 760 Autoloading and Pump Rifles  
Added BDL Deluxe grades

Models 552 & 572 Autoloading and Pump Rim Fire Rifles  
Added new BDL Deluxe grades

Model 40XB Introduced in Center Fire Match Grade, box magazine,  
and also available with special trigger as option.

Model 700 Introduced a Military Sniper version for use by  
U.S. Marine Corps.

 44 Rem. Mag., 308 Win.
- Model 700      Added varmint grade rifle in several calibers.

1968

- Model 870      Pump Shotgun, restyled for improved finishes and  
 added recoil pad.
- Models 742 & 760      Autoloading and Pump Center Fire Rifles  
 Restyling of stocks with added ornamentation and  
 improved finishes.
- Model 660      Bolt Action Carbine Rifle  
 Redesign of Model 600 eliminating the molded  
 vent rib and with increased barrel length by 2 inches.
- Model 788      Added Caliber 243
- Model 870      Pump Shotgun  
 Law Enforcement Model with special sights,  
 bayonet attachment, etc..
- Model 1100      Autoloading Shotgun  
 Special military version designated as Model 7188,  
 for U.S. Marine Corps and Navy, having special  
 sights and bayonet attachment, special finishes,  
 muzzle device, etc..
