The attached exhibit shows a comparison of the costs requested in your memo dated May 28, 1971.

These comparisons indicate the factory cost of the Model 660 parts less than the Model 700; on a full book basis \$12.75 per 100 less; on a cash basis \$8.96 per 100 less.

Based on the Model 700 #2 Production Forecast, the estimated out-of-pocket cost reduction for the Model 660 components is \$8,010.
