What I am looking for is some information about a Model 700 that I recently purchased in .22-250 caliber. The gun's serial number is 200544 it has a metal buttplate, and the old style checkering. 1966

The store where I purchased the gun said that it had been recently found after having been lost in a warehouse for quite a number of years.

If you can tell me, I would like to know the date that this gun was made. I have been told that this was the 544th Model 700 made in this caliber. Is this true?

I will certainly appreciate any information that you may be able to supply me with about this gun. I like it very much, and after several years in the box, it still was able to produce a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " group at 100 yards, with no sight correction necessary.
