Assembly of the prototype was completed and some testing has been done. Minor charges to the interlock system are being made. Additional testing will begin next week, September 23. No problems with target flight are apparent.

SKEET TRAP

Initial testing of the prototype indicates that our problems with 'arget flight accuracy from the high house has been alleviated by the addition of a small target positioning spring. The first 2500 targets thrown were better targets from all standpoints than those from the 200S or the Hansen. Comparisons with the Winchester-Western skeet trap are planned beginning September 23.

BULLETS
