The rifle will have the following characteristics:

  - d. Rounded pistol grip (no cap)
  - e. Rounded fore-end tip
  - f. Brown rubber butt plate
  - g. Present 700 BDL checkering pattern

3. Jeweled Bolt
4. Hooded Front Sight
5. BDL Floor Plate
6. Offered in 6 cartridges

NEW MECHANICAL TRAP

The seven (7) Standard Mechanical Traps requested by Marketing for a field test have been shipped to the various locations throughout the United States. As soon as Marketing is satisfied with the traps performance the trap design will be ready to release to production.

The Mechanical Trap with the cocking lever and solenoid release is presently being tested by Research. This trap has been cycled 55,000 times with no significant problems. Six more of the solenoid release traps are being fabricated for a marketing field test similar to what is being done with the basic trap.
