## Subpart C—FIREARMS

### 27 CFR 178.11. GENERAL

#### ATF Proc. 78-1

#### SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

This procedure provides guidelines for obtaining lists of Federal firearms licensees, licensed under Title I of the Gun Control Act of 1968 (18 U. S. C. chapter 44), from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms.

#### SEC. 2. BACKGROUND.

The Gun Control Act of 1968 set forth new rules and standards which generated a demand for mailing tapes used to forward copies of local ordinances annually as required by 18 U.S.C. 921(a)(19). Because of administrative and mechanical difficulties, the Bureau has discontinued its practice of furnishing mailing tapes on Federal firearms licensees.

#### SEC. 3. LISTS.

The Bureau now uses microfiche lists of Federal firearms licensees. These lists consist of 50 to 55 4" x 6" plastic cards, each card containing 270 reduced computer printout pages. Reduction ratio is 48X. A special reader is needed to magnify the microfiche to a readable format. The lists, updated periodically, contain the names and addresses of dealers, by State, in license number sequence. Requests for lists will be processed under the Freedom of Information Act.

#### SEC. 4. REQUESTS FOR LISTS.
