## XP100 - MARKING GUNS AND FACKING BOXES

All guns put up by production and repaired by custom repair are to be marked as follows:

- Gun "O" on Receiver tang, left side on flat, just behind vertical face.
- Packing Box "A" on label. This designates optical comparator fire control adjustments.

These guns will have the following components:

- New safety arm .301 radius
- New sear safety cam .020 additional clearance at pin .256 dimension.
- Trigger ears removed from front to provide clearance for screw.

These components are to the latest model drawing changes by R & D.
