SUBJECT: LOW COST BOLT ACTION RIFLE FOR DISCOUNT STORES

Will you please develop high spot costs for a proposed bolt action rifle for distribution through discount chains such as K-Mart. The proposed rifle would be similar to the present Model 700 (long action only) with the following alterations:

o Stock

- Model 700 Classic Shape.
- Process on existing equipment, including Zuckerman Opti-Sand.
- Vinyl finish (same as M/788).
- M/788 Butt Plate.
- No swivel studs or holes.
- No checkering.

o Action

- One piece molded Trigger-guard and floor plate similar to M/600. (P.G. Johnson will furnish details)
- Stamped Magazine Follower.
- Purchased (screw machine) Bolt Handle with secondary machining operations to fit to Bolt Body. (L.B. Bosquet will furnish details)
- M/788 Sights (front and rear) with M/600 Rear Sight Base.
- Finish same as Model 788.
- M/700 ADL Trigger Guard - no floor plate.
