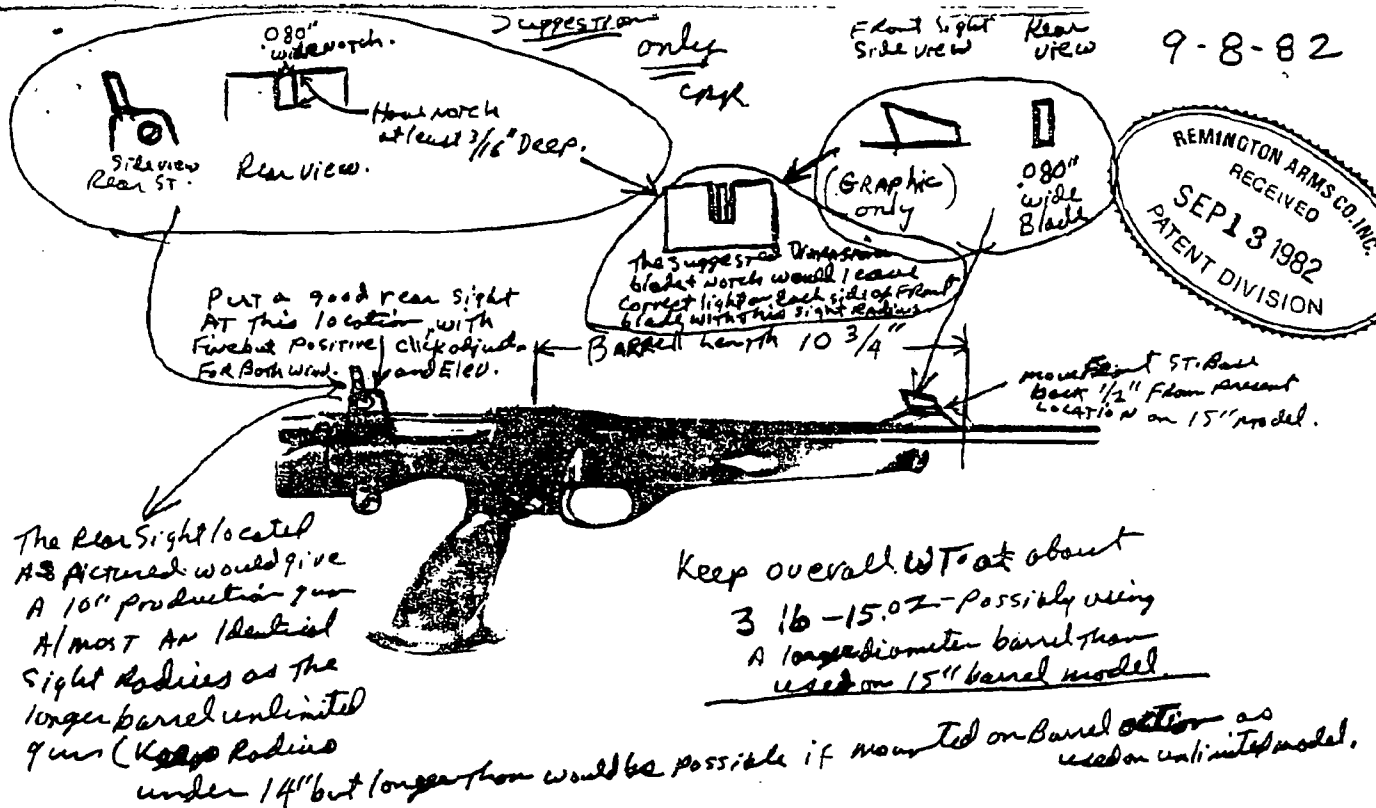




MR. BARRY ESTRIN:

I have signed and returned your agreement as requested in your letter of 8-31-82. I did not have it notarized as I wish to let you know that the reason I suggested this version of the XPR was due to the fact that you had most of the parts in production already that you need to build this pistol, and I have no intention of making any claims against Remington Arms or expect any favors, create any confidential relationships etc., it's merely a constructive suggestion, for a pistol that would fill a legitimate need for a better production class silhouette pistol, for fellow shooters.

I photo-copied a picture of one of your existing XP-100 7 BR. + have sketched in a couple of suggestions to which I would like to see incorporated for a 1st. class production pistol.

I have emphasized the sights especially as in silhouette shooting that's what really makes a difference, providing of course you have an accurate pistol.

At present production rules don't give a limit on sight radius but obviously they wouldn't allow a longer sight radius than used on the unlimited guns. hope you can. any other information kindly Coniel R. Robertson
