SUBJECT: MODEL 700 FEATURES FOR 1983

Our understanding of the meeting held with you on 2-18-82 covered the following features requested by Marketing for 1983:

Model 700 BDL

- Stock made to present model drawing dimensions
- No-bind plated machined or cast follower
- High gloss metal finish on Barrel, Receiver, Bolt Plug, Bolt Handle, Trigger Guard and Floor Plate (knurled bolt handle)

Model 700 ADL

- Classic stock made to present model drawing except end of grip made to take Model Four grip cap
- Model Four grip cap
- Medium gloss finish
- Classic butt pad with red color like that used on M1100 Ltd.Edition model
- Cut checkering 18 line per inch with side panel only. Panels to be same size as the present M700 ADL.
- Sling swivel studs
- High gloss metal finish on Barrel, Receiver, Bolt Plug, Bolt Handle, Trigger Guard and Floor Plate (no knurl on bolt handle).
- No sights (no sight holes in barrel)
- No-bind plated machined or cast follower
- Remington scope mounts.
