Production Support:

General support to production involved preparation for inventory and routine checks while G.D. Sietsema was on vacation. A materials audit was initiated at the request of Anderson Screw Products (Jamestown, N.Y.) for firing pin head blanks. O/U radiographic barrel braze inspection has continued satisfactorily.

R & D Support:

R & D work this month has included release of the O/U and numerous other individual transmittals. A major effort involved support of the Schoenicke v. Remington trial in anticipation of testifying to metallurgical issues. In addition, H.M. Quackenbush help develop 3 prototype black aluminum finisher for 6160 T-6 cantilever mounts. One completely new finish 'black nickel' will be evaluated.
