

Enclosed please find two Remingtons, Model 700, Varmint Special .223 bolt action rifles- Serial #'s A6237986 and A6236452. *R 2226*

These rifles were purchased by this department earlier this year from Wammes Guns Inc., Belle Fontaine, Ohio. Both of these weapons were found defective and when we contacted Wammes, we were informed to return them back to the manufacturer as they would be the only ones who could repair them.

Both these weapons are used by our Tactical Unit, and we will return them as soon as possible.

Both of these weapons were fired less than 100 rounds when it was discovered they were unsafe. With a live round in the chamber and the bolt closed, the safety was moved from the "safe" to "fire" position the weapon would fire. This did not happen every time, but it did happen intermittently.
