Dear Sir,

Thank you for your inquiry & your interest in Remington firearms. You may wish to speak to a custom gunsmith in your area about increasing the accuracy on your Model 710. All of our rifles have the potential to be very accurate. We do not recommend any alterations to your firearm and any alterations will void the warranty.

The bolt on the Model 710 is not like a conventional bolt action rifle. For the last 100 plus years, bolt action rifles have all basically been made the same way; the locking lugs on the bolt lock up into the receiver, while the barrel is screwed on. The Model 710 is a completely new way of thinking. The bolt locks directly into the barrel, and the barrel is hydraulically pressed into the receiver. Also, there are three locking lugs instead of two. This gives the rifle exceptional strength and accuracy.

Since the bolt locks into the barrel, the receiver now simply guides the bolt. The receiver of the Model 710 has a self lubricating synthetic insert to guide the bolt into the barrel. With this new insert, and the three locking lugs, there is a completely different feel. When pushing the bolt forward, there is a different feeling than on the Model 700 or Model Seven. This is because of the contact of the metal bolt and the synthetic insert and is normal. The "feel" is different, but the quality and performance of Remington is still there.

It's not too early to begin planning for next season. At Remington, we offer a number of services to keep you in the hunt and your firearm in peak performance condition.
