

NEW PRODUCTION MODEL 1100" COMPETITION PROVIDES CUSTOM GUN PERFORMANCE FOR THE SERIOUS CLAY TARGET SHOOTER

Madison, NC – Over 40 years after its introduction, the Remington® Model 1100 autoloader is still the choice of many competitive shooters for its superior performance, handling qualities and rich tradition on skeet and trap fields worldwide. New for Spring 2006 is the Model 1100 Competition 12-gauge shotgun, ideal for the sporting clays course, and an adjustable comb version which is sight at home on the trap field. This well-designed autoloader provides the serious target shooter a true high performance shotgun direct from the factory.

With all of the smooth-handling and reliable operating features of the Model 1100 field guns, the Model 1100 Competition package adds the performance-enhancing and classic design features required for today's competitive sporting disciplines. This soft-recoiling, \$2\times gauge autoloader has been optimized to handle \$2^3/4\times inch target and light field loads and features an extended sarrier release for quicker reloading. The 30-inch target-style barrel has a wider 10mm vent rib and is overbored with a diameter of .735". Lengthened forcing cones lessen shot deformity, improve patterns and further reduce the felt recoil of this soft-shooter. Additionally, the barrel is equipped with new extended ProBoreTM custom-designed choke tubes with Skeet, Improved Cylinder, Light Modified, Modified and Full tubes included. Ivory front bead and steel mid-bead sights provide for ease of target acquisition and improved second shot follow-up. Enhancing the performance level, this Model 1100 has a nickel-plated. Teflon@ finish on internal operating parts (action bars, action bar sleeve, action spring, locking block, harmer, sear and magazine tube) and on the trigger, carrier release and receiver assembly. This slick extra layer of finish improves cleaning as well.

The Model 1100 Competition features a semi-funcy, B grade American walnut stock with handsome hi-gloss finish and cut-checkering. A non-glare, bead blasted top and bottom radius compliments the polished satin finish on the receiver sides and the barrel has a high polish blued finish. Designed to provide proper fit, the competition-style stock has a $1^{1}/_{2}$ -inch drop at the comb, $2^{1}/_{4}$ -inch drop at the heel and $14^{1}/_{4}$ -inch length of pull and is fit with the R3 \oplus receil part. The Adjustable Comb version, ideal for trap shooting, can be set to a low of $1^{1}/_{2}$ -inches at the comb and $2^{1}/_{4}$ -inches at the heel. This target gun is designed for maximum performance and custom-fit to meet every sheeter's needs.

History speaks for itself, more competitive shooters look to Remington to provide a reliable well-designed, high performance shotgain when every target counts. The **Model 1100 Competition** 12 gauge autoloading shotgan is available at a suggested retail price of \$1275 and the Adjustable Comb version is available at \$1449.
