John - Tim happened to be here at the office today and he and I talked about the FBI rifle trigger pull issue. The contract calls for 3 lb - 4.5 lbs trigger pull with more points being given for the preferred 3.75 lbs. WE BOTH AGREED that it is worth the sacrifice of the bonus points to insure that the trigger does not fire in the drop tests by setting it at 4 - 4.25 lbs. With the fact that the rifle fired on vertually ALL of the muzzle drops on and off safety from 4 ft. We felt it best to play it on the safe side. If you disagree, please talk to Tim and / or call me at home. We can always reach Norm on monday morning if we decide differently.

Norm - unless you hear from John, Tim or I, when you go in to set the trigger pull - set it at 4 - 4.25 lbs.
