I would say 500 rounds should suffice. Also, in addition to recoil endurance, don't you think it might be prudent to subject the stock to Jar off and Rotation type testing as well? The reason I say this is because we have recently encountered an issue with the Model 504 stock. When subjected to Jar-off and Rotation testing, 6 of 6 stocks broke when dropped from a height of 1ft. We are having to re-evaluate the grip diameter because breaking stocks from a 1ft drop is unacceptable from a warranty perspective. Let me know what you think.
