Muzzleloaders

Saddle Lock Muzzleloader has big trigger on top of gun. These types of muzzleloaders are no longer made that much.

IN LINE Muzzleloader is BOLT ACTION Technology. This made the gun easier to clean.

Muzzleloaders are loaded from the end of the barrel.

Black Powder = Slower rate of burn (Black Powder is a nitro glycerin based) Smokeless Powder = More Pressure and Better Vilocity.

Pyrodex Black Powder is what Remington recommends for Remington Muzzleloader Guns

When loading the barrel for muzzleloader the black powder is loaded by volume and NOT by weight.

When loading a cartridge the black powder is loaded by weight and NOT by volume.

Model 700 Muzzleloader has a optimal load of 90 - 120 grams.

Sabot :::::

The sabot is based on the Model 700. Remington recommends the sabot for use with the 700 Muzzleloader.

Sabot Type Projectile – A sub-caliber projectile centered in a lightweight carrier to permit firing the sub-caliber projectile in a larger caliber firearm.

Sabot is a plastic piece placed behind the projectile.

90 - 120 grains of powder will give the best results

The lands and groves inside the barrel make the sabot and projectile twist.

Round Balls are used with shooting patches. The round balls are NOT as accurate as sabots.

Lead Conical is just a chunk of lead.

Wonder Wads are cotton 1/8" thick. Wonder Wads cushion the sabot and makes a seal. Also, suppose to make the shot more accurate.
