What are the differences between these assemblies so that we can provide a proper response to send out for this? I don't want to start another fireball for another model.

I purchased a Model 7 Youth model for my son, in 1996. Recently, there was a shooting accident near here involving a model 700, and there is much in the papers regarding problems with inadvertant firing of the Model 700.

Is the trigger and safety mechanism in the Model 7 the same as in the Model 700?
