Guys,

As part of the budget presentation that Paul and I presented yesterday, we made the statement that the SPL would be an additional cost of \$7 as compared to the current fire control. Assuming 150,000 units involved, it would be an additional cost of \$1.1MM to the business. However, based on the budget we created for the new department (i.e. 18773), and the current routings, it looks like the cost may be more like \$12 more than the current fire control. Before we go too far down the road, I'd like you to review the information (i.e. B.O.M.; routers; manpower; spending) and make sure that we are comfortable with it. There are some assumptions such as the \$1,000/day in tooling cost that I'd like someone to confirm.

I'd like a response by the end of the day today, so we can proceed with the budget process. Please call me with any questions.
