I was concerned in regards to the safety reminder for Remington rifles manufactured pre-82 etc. with the "Bolt Lock" feature. Could you tell me what year(s) this model was produced and if there may be a manual available still. Also are repair parts still avail if required? I do not have the serial number at this time but can provide if required. I myself have some model 700 rifles, My model 760 carbine (a true buck masher, Model 1100 and 870 shotguns, and Remington 22 rifles,) I also used the M40 Marine Corps 7.62 Sniper rifle in the Marine Corps, 1959-1981, (Viet Nam).
