I recently removed the trigger from my Remington 700 VS SF. Before I removed the trigger I removed the safety lever. In the course of removing these parts a ball bearing fell out; I think this occurred when I removed the safety lever. I can't figure out where this ball bearing goes now.

Can you please provide me with a picture or instructions for reassembly showing the ball bearing?

I have an owners manual but the trigger assembly is not exploded; it is shown as a unit. Do you have a more detailed diagram that you can e-mail me?
