I purchased this rifle in aprox. 1964 from Sears Roebuck Co. I used it for some years and had a problem with the rifle discharging a round when the bolt was closed I stopped hunting with the rifle out of fear. In S. Maryland I used a shotgun. Now 25 years later, I am back in Kentucky and thinking of using my 700. During an inspection of the breech I closed the bolt and the bolt handle came off. Now I have two problems, one, a bolt that can cause a round to fire when it is closed and two, broken bolt handle. Can you help me with advise to properly repair my, almost new, 40 year old Model 700?
