ISSUES

- Owners Manual Change the owners manual immediately to have the instructions for both ISS and non-ISS firearms.
- 2. Phase in the non-ISS firearms. Do not establish a transition date.
- Presently the box end labels are marked with a "J" to designate ISS. Eliminate the "J" immediately.
- 4. We need to build a number of non-ISS fire controls.
 - a. In the case of the bolt actions, we need to evaluate with the old fire control with the ISS MIM trigger.
 - b. In the case of shot gun fire controls we need to evaluate with the new MIM trigger.
- 5. Drop testing will be required
- 6. We will need to develop a list of all parts taken out and being put in.

- 10. Review the "shark fins" requirement on the shot gun fire control
- 11. Go back to the screw machine safety button? Make the button longer?
- 12. Which firearms lock to now use, cable?
- 13. Police use trigger lock instead of cable lock.

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
