We have examined the firearm and determined that the Fire Control Mechanism (Trigger Assembly) is in need of repair or replacement. In its current condition, the rifle may not operate in a safe or reliable fashion. Accordingly, the rifle should not be used unless and until the trigger assembly has been appropriately repaired or replaced. - You have instructed Remington Arms Company, Inc. to return the firearm to you in its present condition, and not to make the recommended repairs.
