

rifle safety. I recommend that you install a 3 position safety on new production model 700's. This is a very simple solution to a hazardous problem. Perhaps you only have this sort of a legal problem with only one out of a million rifles, but would not the cost of altering production tooling be less than the cost of several legal battles with the likes of Mr. Campbell?

A significant part of my life is spent around firearms and also the same for the people that I associate with. A common reasoning that I hear often is that someone prefers to hunt with a Winchester over other types of rifles because of the 3 position safety. I own several makes of rifles including a Remington but I usually hunt with my Winchester for the same reasoning. In my opinion a Remington rifle is much better built but it is not safer.

The Remington model # 725 has an excellent safety that you should seriously consider installing on new production model # 700's. This would make a fine and safe rifle.
