This office represents the rights and interests of Mary May, administrator of her husband, Harry May's estate. Harry May was the owner of the above named Remington Model 600. It is my understanding that your company received the above named firearm from Wayne Barrows of Barrows Trading Post in Quechee, Vermont for inspection and repair. It is also my understanding that Mr. Barrows indicated to you that the firearm was involved in a serious accident in which Mr. May was killed. Further, I understand that you did replace the trigger mechanism on the firearm under the recall. You kept the old trigger mechanism.

Since you were aware that this firearm was involved in a death, and that the death may have been caused by a defect in the trigger mechanism of the firearm, I assume you have kept the part you replaced.

Please let me know if you still have possession of the trigger mechanism, and what arrangements can be made for this office to take possession of the mechanism. I expect a reply by April 29, 1994.
