On November 26, 1984 while hunting deer here in Virginia I had a accident with a rifle of your manufacture. Please allow me to explain.

As I come out of the woods near dark I met a friend in an open field. We decided to go in for the day and I said wait till I unload my rifle. I pointed the rifle at the ground in front of us as he watched and pushed the safety forward. When the safety was released the rifle fired and just damn near tore my thumb off. The recoil drove the safety into my right thumb, split it open about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches and about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch deep.
