Dear Sir,

I am returning to you my Remington Model Seven 308 Cal. rifle, Serial No. 7646466 which I recently purchased.

The problem I have is that the rifle will accidentally go off when I push off the safety. This will happen about two out of ten times. Recently this happened at a local rifle range and fortunately no one was hurt. The results could have been a disaster.

The malfunction had not occurred for maybe the first twenty-five (25) shots I fired, but now there are times when the rifle won't even cock, and like I mentioned before there are times it will go off when pushing the safety to the fire position.

I called the factory to verify if the serial number was of the rifles that were called back for safety reasons, they assured me it was not.

I have purchased a BELL & CARLSON fiberglass stock for this rifle and the problem seems to be more pronounced when it is in use.
