Dear Mr. Cole:

Your letter of January 6, 1987 that was addressed to our Wilmington, Delaware offices, regarding the safety operation of your new left hand Model 700 BDL 270 Win caliber rifle, has been forwarded to this office for response.

All Model 700 rifles produced after 1981 do not have the "bolt-lock" feature, i.e.- the bolts can be raised with the safety in the "on-safe" position. Older Model 700 rifles do lock the bolt with the safety on.

The bolt-lock was eliminated based on the results of an independent marketing survey in which a greater percentage of the shooters felt it was not a necessary feature and preferred the capability of opening the bolt with the safety on.

If you desire the bolt-lock feature on your rifle, we can install the necessary part at a charge of \$15.00 to cover part, installation and handling. If you are interested, please send the rifle via insured U.P.S. to:
