Glue is smeared on both sides of the stock at the diamond inlay. Is there a special solvent which will remove the glue? A gun of this quality should not look like this. This is my 8<sup>th</sup> Remington gun, and it is not the usual quality I've grown to expect from Remington.

Now, on another subject Remington should bring back their 16 guage shot guns, the finest upland hunting guns ever made.
