- 3. I would also like a floor plate installed, so I don't have to min rounds into the chamber unless I intend to fire one.

P.S. I have subsequently duplicated the above failure. I placed a fired, empty case in the chamber, to avoid firing pin damage and operated the bolt several times, and sequentially operated the safety lever and the firing pin was released without touching the trigger. Periodically I did pull the trigger while the safety was on.
