Dear Mr. Hynst:

Reference is made to your recent letter regarding Remington removal of the bolt-lock feature from the Model 700 rifle.

All Model 700 rifles produced after 1981 do not have the "bolt-lock" feature, i. e. the bolts can be raised with the safety in the "on-safe" position. As you know, older Model 700 rifles do lock the bolt with the safety on.

The bolt-lock was eliminated based on the results of an independent marketing survey in which a greater percentage of the shooters felt it was not a necessary feature and preferred the capability of opening the bolt with the safety on.

If you should, someday, decide to buy a Model 700 rifle, our Arms Service Dept., can install the necessary part to lock the bolt down on safety at a charge of \$15.00 to cover part, installation and handling. If you so desire, send the rifle via insured U.P.S. to:
