This gun discharges whenever you close the bolt and lock it without anyone touching the trigger. When this happened last year, I took it to a gunsmith in Potter County, PA where I was hunting. The gunsmith looked at the gun and said that he knew what was wrong with the gun without even looking at it. I left it there for two hours and when I returned, I paid \$15.00 for the repairs. The gunsmith assured me that I no longer needed to worry. I left feeling pretty good.

This year I took the gun out to get the scope sighted in and, once again, the gun discharged as soon as I closed the bolt and locked it. Again I did not touch the trigger. It was very lucky that noone was around me when the gun discharged. I am very upset at what could have happened and would like your assurance that you can repair this gun for good before I have a tragic accident. I have always liked Remington guns and I am sure that you will recognize the seriousness of this problem and help rectify the situation.
