Reference is made to your letter of February 24, 1984, regarding the subject claim.

In reviewing our records, it was noted that the Model 700 ADL 30-06 caliber rifle, serial number B6407007, that was involved in Mr. Abbott's unfortunate incident was received at our factory from K-Mart #9504-80 on January 23, 1984. Accompanying the rifle was a returned goods memo which simply stated "safety didn't hold". No mention was made of any property damage. Examination of the firearm revealed no factory defects, and the trigger assembly was replaced at no-charge, strictly as a gesture of good-will to your K-Mart store.

Based on our findings, we cannot assume any responsibility or liability for this incident. Had we been notified of the nature of the incident prior to the return of the rifle, we could have responded directly to Mr. Abbott. The rifle was return shipped to K-Mart on February 27, 1984.
