I own a Remington 700 S/N
A6412209, which was purchased APPROX
eight years ago. Two years ago
while sighting in my rifle and
while inserting a live shell into
the chamber, with the bolt, the
rifle discharged. Rifle was taken
to a local gunsmith and no
problems were found.

Last year, while deer hunting
I was unloading my rifle, shells
were removed from the magazine and
when I lifted up on the bolt to
remove the round in the chamber
the gun went off and the bolt
drove to the rear.

My rifle is in excellent
condition and has fired approximately
50 rounds since purchase, however
I am frightened this may happen
again.

I have taken it to a
certified gunsmith and nothing
wrong has been found. I feel
something is wrong with the action
on this rifle for it to do
