Several years ago I bought this gun new (Model 700-Serial #B6502403) especially for a western hunt which I had booked at quite an expense to me. I had only time to sight it in before leaving. On the hunt and several times since then, when trying to shoot at game, the gun wouldn't fire. By this I mean, the trigger wouldn't pull and when I tried to move the safety back on, the gun would fire on its own. The gun works fine often enough to keep me off guard, but when it hangs up it is extremely dangerous.

I have since bought a new rifle from a competitor which works fine but I like the looks and the feel of the Remington. I was going to sell it but someone else would be getting my problem.

Lately I have learned of two other people with the same gun and the same problem. This almost sounds like a recall item, but at any rate, it is a hazard and needs fixing.
