Dear Sir:

I've been having some problems with my Remington gun that I thought you ought to know about.

Several years ago, about 1978 or 1979 the gun misfired with my wife in Douglas, Wyo. She was carrying the gun with the safety on.

Then in 1983, I bolted the shell into the chamber and it went off. The same thing happened three more times in 1984.

I have never used any shells except factory loads. The gun is a Model 700 BDL. It is approx. 8 years old. It is used about once a year during hunting season.

Thought this information would be of interest to you. There is evidently a flaw in the gun and it needs to be checked by a factory representative.

When and where could I meet with a rep. to work out a solution?

I would not consider trading or selling this gun until it is fixed because I would not want to feel responsible for a fatal accident.

Please advise as to what I need to do.
