The fact that the rifle can be fired by inserting a tool to push up on the connector does not show a malfunction, or indicate that the rifle would ever malfunction in the field.

Thank you for this opportunity to examine the rifle, report our findings and to be of service. Further, with the Campbell lawsuit still pending, it would be best for you to simply continue your work as a Remington New Gun Repair Station in a normal fashion, and not feel compelled to correct the rumors you are told regarding that case.
