




Dear Sirs:

I have two Remington rifles that I have had trouble with and thought you might be able to help solve the problems.

The first rifle is a Mod. 700, Ser. #6857265, Cal. 25-06. I had a premature discharge when I pushed the safety forward. I am sure I did not pull the trigger, as I had my hand on the outside of the trigger guard.

The second rifle is a Mod. 722, Ser. #208795, Cal. 222. On two different occasions I have ejected an unfired cartridge, leaving the projectile in the barrel. The ammo being used was 222 Remington (55 Gr metal case - R222R4-C 29K D6637). The barrel is clean and free of foreign objects.

Any help you can give me in correcting these problems will be greatly appreciated.
