Dear Mr. Scheuer:

We have our ballistics report on the one fired 270 Win cartridge which was sent to us from our firearms plant by Mr. Jim Stekl.

Our technician performed a head hardness test on the case and found that the head was soft. This allowed it to expand when fired and release the primer from the primer pocket.

We sincerely apologize for this annealing error and for the problem caused by this defect. We understand from Mr. Stekl's letter to you that the gun is being repaired at the firearms plant and will be returned directly to you at the above address.

To compensate for the problem caused, please find enclosed a check to cover the cost of two fresh boxes of 270 Win cartridges.

We also request that you return your remaining unfired rounds for disposal at our plant, as suggested by Mr. Stekl. Please ship them via United Parcel Service, collect, marked to my attention.

We hope this is satisfactory and we appreciate your support of our products. Please advise if we can be of any further service.
