

Thank you for advising us of your client's accident. In order for Remington to evaluate the cause of this accident, and to investigate whether it may be responsible, we will have to examine the exhibit, Model 700 rifle, serial number A6897821, at our laboratory in Ilion, New York. I can assure you that no destructive testing will be conducted, and the condition of the exhibit will not be altered, except that we would request that we be allowed to strip down a few of the remaining unfired rounds in order to examine the components. As soon as the examination is completed, the exhibits will be returned, and they will be followed by a written report on their findings.
