cocked. Then, ~~to~~ levered the bolt
and the gun cocked. When I flipped
the safety off the firing pin dropped.
Had there been a round in the chamber
it would have went off. I pulled the
action out of the stock, to see if someth
obvious was wrong. I found nothing over
