On one occasion, it failed to fire upon release of the safety and pull of the trigger. After working the safety back α forth several times it fired without pulling the trigger.

At another time, it fired while loading another round into the chamber without touching the trigger.

May I have authorization to return the rifle for inspection & repair. If there is to be a charge, please advise as I would rather trade it than spend a lot of money on it.
