
This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated November 13, 1986.

Remington is very interested in determining the cause of the malfunction you described, and toward that end we would request that the subject rifle be sent to Remington's firearms laboratories in Ilion, New York for our examination. I can assure you that the condition of the rifle as received will not be modified and no destructive testing will be performed. The rifle will be returned to you (either corrected or not corrected if there proves to be a malfunction, at your direction) as soon as the examination has been completed, followed by a report on our findings.
