I recently purchased a Remington, model 788-243 cal. rifle with 4x32- telescopes for my twelve year old son. I am please with the rifle in every way except for the safety and its position on the stock. It seems that whenever my son is carrying the rifle, the weight of it has a tendency to cause the rifle to slide back against his right hand thumb knuckles, and thus releasing the safety without his realizing it!
