off. We try to be very careful and  
safe while hunting, but I am  
scared to death of using this rifle  
any more. I bought this rifle while  
visiting friends 250 miles from here,  
and I don't think the dealer  
would take it back for full  
credit or exchange even though it  
is still in the box like new and  
has only been fired 7 times. I would  
like to be able to exchange it  
for a rifle with a higher placed  
safety that would not cause this  
problem. Please advise me what to do.
