Regarding the captioned matter, please be advised I represent Ronald C. Amos, 12706 Indian Springs Road, Big Pool, Maryland 21711.

Mr. Amos has discussed with me his November 2001 ill-fated hunting trip and rifle malfunction at great length. Further, he has provided a wealth of information regarding the Remington Mode 700 and it's history of malfunction.

The documentation includes a January 26, 2001 statement by Remington; a "Limited Distribution" memo dated January 2, 1979 over the signature of R.B. Sperling; considerable documentation from Attorney Richard C. Miller; Monsees, Miller, Mayor, Presley and Amick; several new/T.V. editorials concerning the Model 700; and the names of eight individuals who have experienced the same malfunction with the Model 700.

After reviewing Mr. Amos' documentation, including the correspondence from Remington, it is my opinion there is sufficient evidence to support a cause of action against Remington Arms Company.

Mr. Amos explained his demand that the involved rifle be replaced and that consideration given to this monetary loss. In light of the documented circumstances and the history of this firearm, I am surprised the only offer to Mr. Amos was repair of the firearm.
