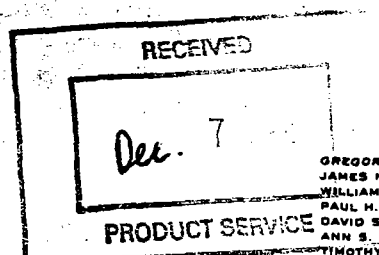

Thanks for your help and hospitality during our recent travels on Seahawk. Pursuant to our discussion, I am enclosing the name and address of the Remington Arms contact. What you described to me is a very dangerous situation and, although this is Remington's busiest time of year and it may take some months for them to return your rifle, it is very important that your rifle be returned to the factory for inspection and any necessary repairs.

As I understand the situation, you bought the rifle new for your father and it has, since that time, occasionally discharged when the safety is released. You explained that spraying the rifle with WD-40 and working the action, temporarily remedies the problem, but that it eventually reoccurs.

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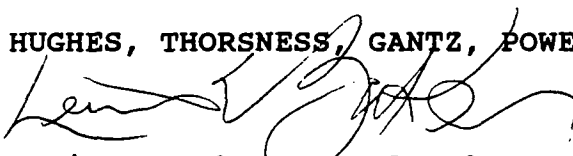
I am sending a copy of this letter to Mr. Stekl, however, you should also send a letter containing a complete explanation of the situation with your rifle.

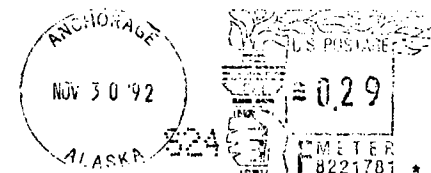
