Customer Service,

I am enclosing an article out of the Montana Standard newspaper which was printed November 5, 2000 in Butte, Montana. I own a Remington Model 700 RDL rifle, Ser. # 6249182 which I purchased in the 1970's. I have also experienced accidental firing by this rifle. I know that I did not touch the trigger when this happened, but I never advised you of the problem. However, with the accidental firing and killing of the nine-year-old boy here in Montana and the other accidental firing and injury of the other person, both reported in this newspaper, I felt that I should go on record with your company of my experiences.

In light of these problems, are you as the manufacturer of the rifle going to correct the problem? If you are not going to correct the problem, what do you recommend that I do. I really do not want to just simply not use the rifle anymore, but I certainly don't want to harm myself or someone else by an accidental discharge from the rifle.

Please advise me as to what I should do. I will keep a copy of this letter and the newspaper in my file in case something does happen.
