safety, the gun fired. I had not even touched the trigger & was totally unprepared ~~and~~ and shocked by what had just happened. I repeated the bolt-action to see what would happen and it mis-fired again! This could have resulted in a tragic situation and hope no one else has experienced the same.

After talking with the gunsmith at Shoe's he determined my trigger had broken. I would appreciate your prompt attention to this matter as I truly miss being able to use my gun and hope you can restore my faith in this product.
